TAMARIND (Fruits – Pulp – Seeds)

Tamarind is one of the fruit crops of high economic value with high export potential. Thailand is the world's top 5 tamarind exporter. Tamarind is a tropical fruit that has a wide variety of uses. There are two types of tamarinds sweet and sour. The fruit contains high levels of tartaric acid, vitamin C and polyphenols.

Sweet tamarinds are usually for direct consumption, as are snacks and confectionery. Commonly, there are five sweet tamarind cultivars with different quantitative characters. Sweet tamarinds are very rich in nutrient and antioxidant properties.


> Sour tamarinds are popular ingredients, especially in Asian cuisine. They are preferably for culinary use, especially in pulp (block) form. As of today, sour tamarinds have no varietal names due to poor demand for direct consumption. Therefore, all sour-tamarindbased products have no significant taste but are sour and aromatic.

Tamarind seeds are the by-product of the tamarind pulp industry. They are the raw materials used in manufacturing tamarind kernel and tamarind kernel powder (TKP). TKP, aka 'tamarind seed gum', is a source of carbohydrates for the adhesive or binding agent in paper and textile printing. It is also essential in making medicine.
